Description			
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
<p>The municipality of Zemné has traditionally organised the BUBBLEU event, to which it invited its twin towns. The venue was the Main Square and the Jedlik House. The project tried to approach all age groups and parts of society, especially the young and the disadvantaged, with the aim of understanding each other's social and political problems and discussing the future of the EU. The main goal of the project was to support democracy, cooperation, volunteers, common values in a changing Europe, with active local and regional participation at the national and supranational level. In addition to the implementation of specific priorities, the event also covered cultural and gastronomic topics during the 2-day project. The citizens of our community and twin partners understood the positive aspects of the EU and learned how to participate in the decision-making process. An important element of our project was expanding knowledge about the EU, dispelling skepticism about the future of the EU, supporting communication between generations and nations, and strengthening tolerance in the long term. The specialty of the project was traditionally the production of wine spritz, which entered the Slovakian book of records due to its quantity. Information about the project was shared on the website of the event and the partners, in the national press and in the electronic media. Video interviews were conducted with the participants, and we asked their opinions on democracy, migration and tolerance.</p> <p>The programme of the two-day event was as follows:</p> <p>Friday: Krisztián Mészáros - photo exhibition,</p> <p>Nikolas Döme - photo exhibition Ukraine through EU eyes or Ukraine and the EU (Kiev, Kharkov bombing, Chernobyl)</p> <p>Richard Nagy - 3D exhibition: buildings of Europe</p> <p>József Berényi (former State Secretary for Foreign Affairs): lecture on the future of the EU, meeting with young people</p> <p>exchange of experience with representatives of local authorities</p> <p>workshop for young people on how the EU works and the EU Solidarity Fund</p> <p>Scouts: EU quiz</p> <p>Rock concerts - EU-Rock</p> <p>Saturday: EU tent with information materials, cooking competition: tastes of Europe, popular music concerts and folklore, making a record of wine fizz sold for charity.</p>
